These are comprehensive and there are no retakes.

ASSIGNMENTS (HW) 30% Homework will be assigned most class periods and will need to completed by the beginning of the next class period. It must be done in pencil and work must be shown.

Each assignment is worth 20 points and will be scored as following:

- \Rightarrow 20 pts. for HW completed on-time AND has a score of at least 80%. If HW has a score of less than 80%, but was completed at the start of class, it will need to be fixed and turned in before the unit test.
- ⇒ 16 pts. for LATE HW completed at 100%, turned in BEFORE unit test
- \Rightarrow 12 pts. for LATE HW completed at 100%, turned in AFTER unit test
- \Rightarrow 1 pt. for HW that needs to be fixed or redone. This could be based on that work needs to be shown and/or needs to 100% correct.

Unit Tests 35%

- Students must pass EVERY
 Unit Test with a minimum of 80%. If they don't their grade will go to an "I".
- Students will need to retest, but scores will be averaged.
- Students will be required to finish missing work and do test corrections before retaking the Unit Test.
